

Meridian Police Activities League SOCCER PLAY-UP FORM SPRING 2008

In granting my permission, I release the above-mentioned soccer organization from all responsibility should my child be injured, no matter how seriously, while training, practicing, and playing with the older team I am assigned to, and will not hold the Meridian Police Activities League, or the opposing team liable for any injuries that might occur. I have considered my child's maturity, size, coordination, muscular development, attitude, and social development in comparison to the members of the older team.
